They have even taken it so far as to reach out to anyone who did not comment that morning to see if they are sick or dying!

Adding a buddy (or 12) can add so very much to your spiritual life. First, it adds accountability. You will have someone pulling for you to keep going even when you are feeling untouched by the previous day's devotion. By also making time to discuss or comment with another, we face an expectation to provide a thoughtful response, which requires a more thoughtful engagement with the Word thus making our spiritual intake more fruitful. Secondly, a buddy adds community to our journey. You have heard me often say that none of us grow in isolation. Lifechanging growth happens as we engage the Word of God in relationship with other people. Finally, having a partner increases your ministry effectiveness. We have a saying in Celebrate Recovery: We increase our ability, stability, and responsibility when we increase our accountability to God.
